Frequently Asked Questions:

Where is the camp held? Camp is held both indoors and outdoors at the Heart of the Valley Animal Shelter campus.

What are the camp hours? 9:00am to 3:00pm. We are available for pick-up and drop-off for 30 minutes before and after each session.

What is the cost? \$225.00 per week

Will my child interact with animals? Yes!

Are snacks included? Snacks are included, but lunch is not. Children must bring their own sack lunch each day.

Are the activities age-appropriate? Yes! Campers will be divided into smaller age groups when appropriate for the activity.

Can we enroll for more than one week?

Yes! However, much of the same material and activities will be covered each week.

How many children will be in each session? Each session is limited to 15 students.
