HOV only accepts feral cats for TNR (Trap-Neuter-Return). Feral cats are not adoptable and are not accepted for surrender. (A feral cat is a free roaming, wild-living domestic cat that avoids human contact. It does not allow itself to be handled or touched by humans. Even with long-term attempts at socialization, feral cats usually remain fearful making life in the shelter extremely stressful and inhumane for them.)
